make the most of available resources, including time and budget constraints.

Diplomacy and negotiation are skills that can be developed and honed over time through education, practice, and real-world experience. Additionally, ethical behaviour and a commitment to the principles of diplomacy, such as diplomacy being a tool for the peaceful resolution of conflicts, are core values that should guide the actions of today's youth.
